- b. A variety of topics will be incorporated into the annual plan. Good nutrition, managing hypertension, managing anxiety, substance use disorders, effects of smoking and sexually transmitted infections are examples of topics that may be offered. The Division of Medical and Forensics leadership may modify the annual plan based on contemporary issues. For example, a community outbreak of hepatitis A, flu outbreak, a novel virus, or Ebola would result in priority education status that might delay another planned education strategy.
3. All health education, whether in an individual or group setting, shall be evidence based, incorporating standards of health education from reliable sources such as public health agencies, Centers for Disease Control, and peer-reviewed research.
